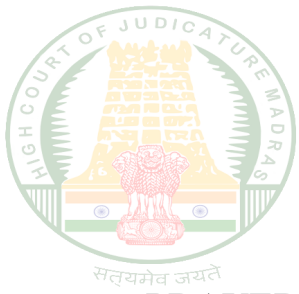

3. After submitting for a brief while, the learned counsel for petitioner would submit that they would confine their prayer for an opportunity of hearing before the appropriate respondent before they proceed with survey.

4. Mr.A.Selvendran, learned Special Government Pleader for respondents would submit that a notice has already been issued to the petitioner and as a matter of fact enquiry was to be conducted.

5. In view of the submissions now made, the 3rd respondent shall issue notice to the petitioner and thereafter proceed with survey in compliance with the order of this Court in W.P.No.2601 of 2025 dated 29.01.2025. Agreed to by the learned counsel for petitioner.
