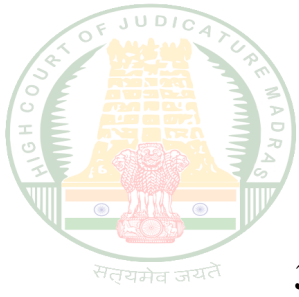

ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by *M.S.RAMESH, J.*)

This Writ Petition has been filed challenging the impugned order dated 29.05.2025, rejecting the representation of the petitioner dated 07.05.2025 and to direct the second respondent to grant parole for a period of six (6) months without escort to the petitioner's husband/convict prisoner.

2. Since the petitioner's husband/convict prisoner has not completed two years of imprisonment, he is ineligible to avail ordinary leave in view of Rule 22(b) of the Tamil Nadu Suspension of Sentence Rules, 1982.
