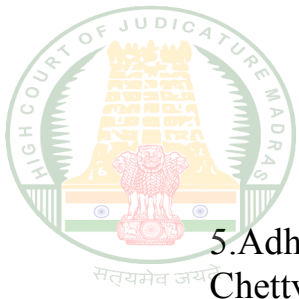

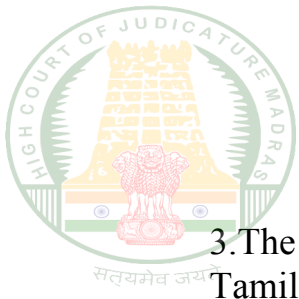

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3. Learned Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of the Tamil

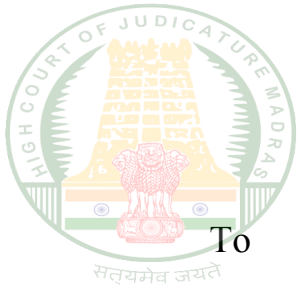
