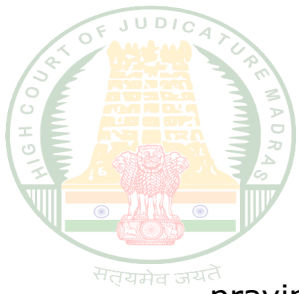

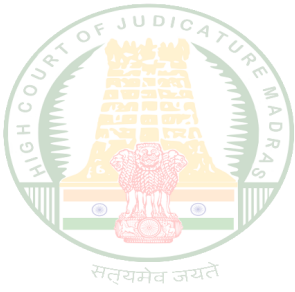

After some arguments, Mr.C.Veera Raghavan, learned counsel for writ petitioners sought leave of this Court to withdraw the captioned main 'Writ Petition' (hereinafter 'WP' for the sake of brevity) and captioned 'Writ Miscellaneous Petitions' (hereinafter 'WMPs' for the sake of brevity) but made a plea to preserve all the rights and contentions of the writ petitioners to pursue statutory appeal remedy under Section 10 of 'The Tamil Nadu Land Encroachment Act, 1905 (Tamil Nadu Act III of 1905)' {hereinafter 'said 1905 Act' for the sake of brevity}. 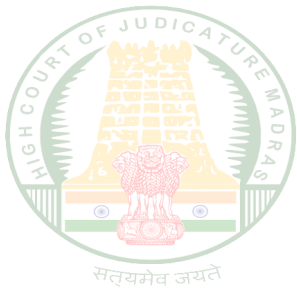

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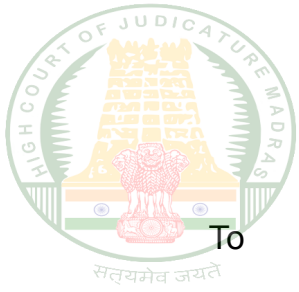

Though obvious we make it clear that if writ petitioners resort to remedy of statutory appeal under Section 10 of said 1905 Act subject to limitation and subject to exclusion of time spent in this WP vide Section 14 of The Limitation Act, 1963, the same shall be heard on its own merits and in accordance with law by R1/Appellate Authority untrammelled by withdrawal of captioned WP.

5. Captioned WP and captioned W.M.P. Nos.24036 and 24038 of 2025 are disposed of as closed/withdrawn. There shall be no order as to costs.

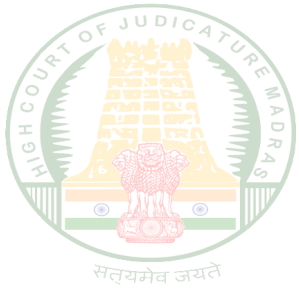
