ORDER

Heard Mr.L.P.Shanmugasundaran, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr.M.Muthusamy, learned Government Advocate and Mr.U.Baranidharan, learned counsel for the 2nd respondent.

2. The instant writ petition has been filed claiming a sum of Rs.8,95,681/- on account of remaining /balance retirement benefits.

3. However, the 2nd respondent disputed the petitioner's claim by filing the counter statement. In spite of filing the counter statement, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the 2nd respondent as well as the learned Government Advocate appearing for the first respondent would fairly submit that they would consider the representation of the petitioner within a reasonable time.

4. In such view of the matter, without going into the merits of the matter, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 07.12.2024 and pass orders on it's own merits



and in accordance with law, of course in the light of the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *S. Andiyannan v. Joint Registrar, Co-operative Societies*, reported in **2015 SCC OnLine Mad 8844**, within a period of eight(8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order On consideration of the above representation in accordance with law, and if the petitioner is eligible for any amount, he is entitled to the statutory interest as provided under the Statutes.

5. In the result, this writ petition stands disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
