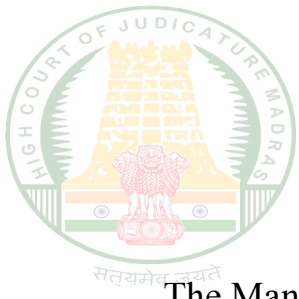

After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Today, the petitioner and the 2nd respondent are present. The matter has been amicably settled between the parties. Both the parties agreed to treat the date of removal of the workman as voluntarily retired from service to pay the retirement benefits including pension to the 2nd respondent / B. Sakthivel,



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Conductor, Emp. No.C15444 of Tambaram from the period of date of appointment to the date of removal i.e., from **04.01.1997 to 07.03.2022** and also pension from the date of this order.

With the above said compromise, the award is passed. The order of the Board Resolution shall form as part and parcel of this Award. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

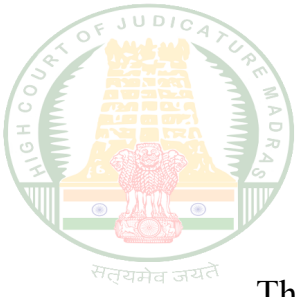
