Revision Petitioner and Ms.R.Gowri, learned Counsel appearing for the

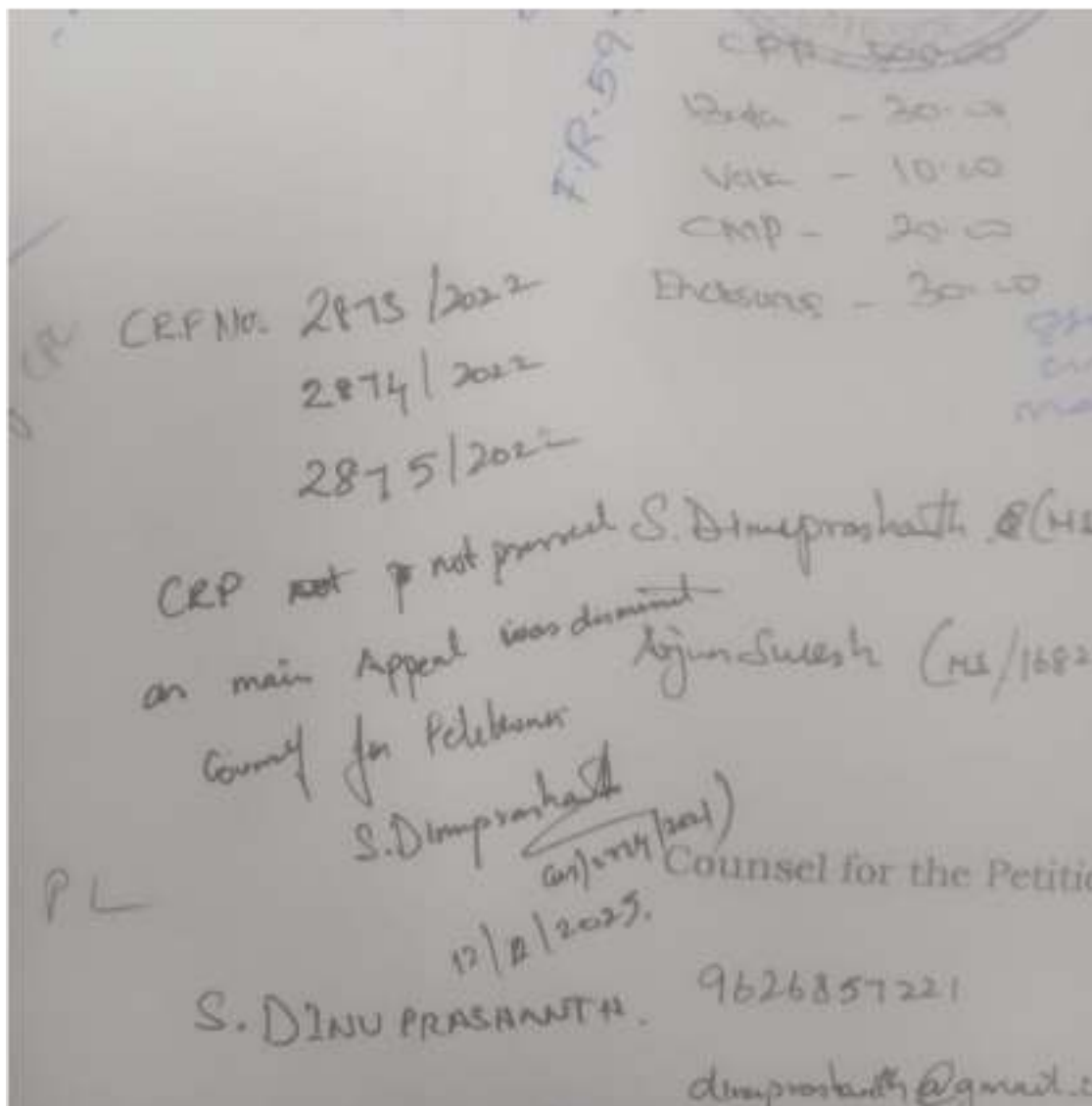


first Respondent are before this Court.
