Even thereafter, a notice for enquiry was given on 18.09.2024. Since there was no progress, the present writ petition has been filed before this Court.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the materials placed before this Court, there shall be a direction to the first respondent to proceed further with the enquiry after affording an opportunity to all the parties concerned and pass final orders within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

This writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
