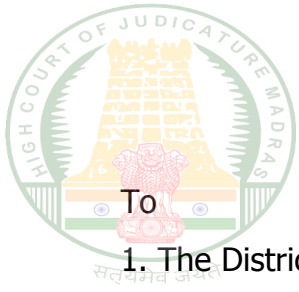

The petitioner is the mother and she has 5 children and among 5 children, 2 children are living with the petitioner in the very same building and the second son is living in the ground floor and the third son is living in the second floor. The said 2 children one or other way had given a trouble and trying to usurp the property in a third hand manner, morefully, the 2 sons have committed unlawful and illegal activities against the petitioner's wish and hence, the petitioner has sought for Police protection for her life and limb.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the first respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 11.06.2025 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
