ORDER

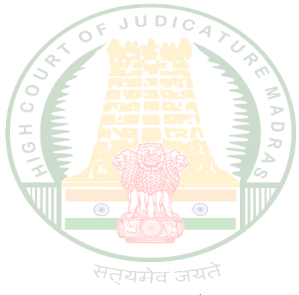
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When the matter came up for hearing, both the complainant and the accused were present before this Court.

3. In view thereof, this criminal revision is disposed of and the conviction of the petitioner/ M. Mallika for an offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and the sentence imposed on the petitioner by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court, Dharmapuri, vide judgment dated 05.01.2021 in C.C.No.14 of 2018 and confirmed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Dharmapuri, vide judgment dated 27.07.2021 in Crl.A.No.4 of 2021 is hereby set aside and the offence is treated to have been compounded between the parties.
