This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 2134 days in filing the above Civil Miscellaneous Appeal against the award dated 29.04.2019 passed in M.C.O.P.No.144 of 2017, on the file of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, District Court No.II, Kancheepuram.

2. Mr.V.Varadha Kamaraj, learned counsel for appellants submitted that certified copies were made ready on 18.07.2019. He would submit that after the death of first appellant's husband, who was the only breadwinner of their family and they struggled for survival itself and due to financial constraints, they went to native place and also due to illness, the first appellant is not able to instruct counsel on record to prefer the above appeal and only during month of June 2025, she gave papers to him, as a result of which, there is a delay of 2134 days in filing the above Civil Miscellaneous Appeal arose, which is neither willful nor wanton. Therefore, he filed this petition to condone the delay in filing the above Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

3. Despite service of notice, there is no representation on the side of 2nd respondent and service awaited for 1st respondent.



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4. Considering the facts and circumstances, and the reasons stated by the petitioner in the affidavit is justifiable one, this court is inclined to allow this petition. Registry is directed to number the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal if it is otherwise found to be in order. The interest for the delay period is ordered to be waived.
