This order will now dispose of the captioned 'Writ Miscellaneous Petition' [hereinafter 'WMP' for the sake of brevity].

2. Captioned WMP has been filed with a prayer to dispense with production of 'original order dated 14.07.2022 passed in O.A.No.106 of 2022' {hereinafter 'impugned order' for the sake of brevity, convenience and clarity}.
