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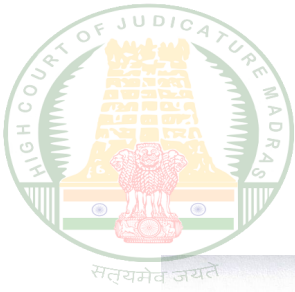

JOINT COMPROMISE MEMO

1. It is submitted that the civil revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India to set aside the Lok Adalat Award passed by the District Legal Service Authority, Thiruvallur vide their proceedings L.A.C.No.337 of 2022 in S.T.C. No.40 of 2020 on the file of Fast Track (Magistrate Level),



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Tiruvallur, dated 20.07.2022 and consequently direct the Learned Fast Track Magistrate, Tiruvallur to proceed with trial in S.T.C No.40 of 2020 in accordance with Law.

2. It is submitted that the respondent borrowed a sum of Rs.10,00,000 for the business purpose from the petitioner. To discharge the said liability the respondent issued a cheque of drawn on Karnataka Bank Anna Nagar west branch bearing no.796180 dated 19.03.2020 in the favour of the petitioner and the said cheque returned as endorsement insufficient funds on 23.03.2020 and hence the case.
3. It is submitted that the petitioner and the respondent subsequently entered in compromise on 16.03.2025, the respondent herein has paid sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- and the same was received by the petitioner and issued a receipt acknowledging the same.
4. As the result petitioner and the respondent agreed to settle all the disputes amicably and decided to withdraw the proceedings pending against the respondent.
5. The Petitioner in this application undertakes that he will not make any claims nor file any legal proceedings against the Respondent.
6. It is submitted that the petitioner hereby agrees to withdraw the above C.R.P.NO: 3479 Of 2023 on the grounds of compromise.

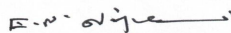

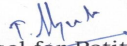
