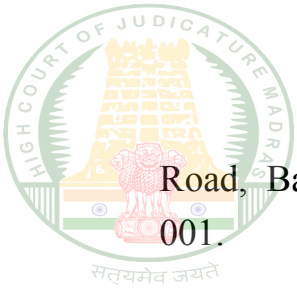

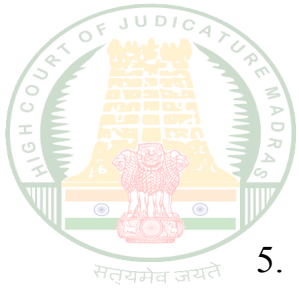
ORDER
