ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody
on 23.04.2025, for the offence punishable under Sections 69 and 75 of BNSS
Act, 2023 and Section 66 E & 67A of IT Act 2000 and Section 4 of TNPHW
Act in Crime No.8 of 2025, registered on the file of the respondent, seeks
bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner on the pretext that he will secure job to the victim girl had taken to a lodge and physically abused her. Hence, the case.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person, he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that A2 in this case has been released on bail. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that the petitioner was arrested on 23.04.2025 and charge sheet has been filed on 20.06.2025 and investigation has been completed. The petitioner mobile phone has been seized as a case property and sent to forensic department. Hence, he opposed to grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the fact that the charge sheet has been filed on 20.06.2025 and investigation has been completed and also considering the facts and circumstances of the case, submissions made by the learned

counsel on either side, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** with **two sureties** each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Metropolitan Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court at Egmore** and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] **the petitioner shall report before the trial Court on all hearing dates without fail;**

[c] the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;

[d] the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly

cause any threat to the de facto complainant and witnesses;

[e] the petitioner to give an undertaking that if required for being identified by witnesses during investigation or for police custody beyond the first fifteen days, he shall comply to the directions as may be given by the Court in this regard;

[f] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
