PRAYER : Civil Revision Petition filed under Section 227 of Constitution of India, pleaded to set aside the impugned judgment dated 12.10.2023 in CRL.A.No.2 of 2022 on the file of the Learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Kancheepuram District at Chengalpattu confirming the order dated 10.12.2021 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Chengalpattu in Crl.MP.No.2301 of 2020 in DVC No. 8 of 2019.

ORDER

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This Civil Revision Petition has been filed against the impugned judgment passed by the Principal District and Sessions Court, Kancheepuram, Chengalpattu, in CRL.A.No.2 of 2022 on 12.10.2023.

2. The brief fact of the case is that the petitioner is the husband and the respondent is the wife and their marriage was solemnized on 11.05.2014 at Odisha and thereafter, they were living at Maraimalai Nagar. During such time, they have jointly purchased an apartment by obtaining loan from PNB Housing Finance Limited. Later, due to some misunderstanding, the respondent had filed D.V.C.No.8 of 2019 before the Additional Mahila Court, Chengalpattu, and also filed a petition in Crl.M.P.No.2301 of 2020 seeking for the interim orders for grant of residential order and for payment of dues in the Bank. The learned Judicial Magistrate, by an order dated 10.12.2021, had granted residential order to the respondent and directed the petitioner to pay the monthly EMI of Rs.38,493/- to the bank. Against which, the petitioner had filed a criminal appeal in Crl.A.No.2 of 2022 before the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Kancheepuram District at Chengalpattu. The



said appeal came to be dismissed on 12.10.2023. Aggrieved over the same, the present

Civil Revision Petition has been filed.

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3. When the matter was listed before this Court on 24.10.2024, on the consent of both sides, this Court had referred the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached to the High Court of Madras, Chennai. Thereby, the parties have appeared before the Mediation Centre and a settlement has been arrived at between them. Pursuant to which, the parties have filed a Settlement Agreement on 20.02.2025. As a sequel, Mediation Report dated 21.02.2025 along with the Settlement Agreement filed by the parties have been filed before this Court.

4. Learned counsel appearing for either side submitted that the matter referred for mediation has been settled and the parties have filed a Settlement Agreement and thereby, prayed that the revision may be disposed based on the Settlement Agreement.

5. Heard the learned counsel appearing for both the petitioner and the respondent and perused the materials available on record. The scanned copy of the Settlement Agreement reads as follows :-



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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Settlement Agreement entered into on 20.02.2025 between

Sandeep Kumar Sahoo, S/o. Ajaya Kumar Sahoo, aged about 37 years, having his permanent residence at Plot No.1245, Mahanadi Vihar, PO-Nayabazar, P.S – Chauliaganj, Cuttack District – 753004 and have come down to Chennai at present, herein after referred as 1st Party

And

Soumya Prava Pal, W/o. Sandeep Kumar Sahoo, aged about 34 years, having her residence at Flat No.E, 17th Floor, Block – Topaz, Olympia Opaline Sequel, Phase – II, OMR Road, Rajiv Gandhi Salai, Navalur Village, Chegalpattu Taluk, Kancheepuram – 600130, herein after referred as 2nd Party

Whereas

1. Disputes and differences had arisen between the Parties hereto and a CRP in C.R.P. No. 3955 of 2024 was filed on 26.07.2024 before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras at Chennai.
2. The matter was referred to mediation/conciliation vide an order dated 24.10.2024 passed by the Hon'ble Mr. Justice A.D. Jagadish Chandira.
3. The Parties agreed that Ms.T. Surekha would act as their Mediator/Conciliator.

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4. Several meetings were held during the process of Mediation/Conciliation from 15.11.2024 to 20.02.2025 and the parties have with the assistance of the Mediator/Conciliator voluntarily arrived at an amicable solution resolving the above-mentioned disputes and differences as enumerated in the Interim Joint Memo of Compromise dated 22.11.2024.

5. The parties hereto confirm and declare that they have voluntarily and of their own free will arrived at this Settlement Agreement in the presence of the Mediator/Conciliator.

6. As per the settlement arrived between the Parties hereto as enumerated in the Interim Joint Memo of Compromise dated 22.11.2024, the parties herein have complied with the agreed terms in the following manner,

- a) The 1st party has withdrawn the C.P.No.194/2020 before the Family Court at Balasore filed by him and the 2nd party has withdrawn the I.A.No.2/2022 in the C.P.No.194/2020, before the Family Court, Balasore filed by her.
- b) The 2nd party has withdrawn the CR.P.No.174/2019 before the Family Court, Balasore filed by her.
- c) The 2nd party has withdrawn the D.V.C.No. 6/2023 and CrI.M.P.No.380/2024 pending before the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Thiruporur filed by her.
- d) Both the party have appeared in C.P.No.255/2024 before the Family Court, Balasore filed under 13(b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and the same has been allowed on 10.02.2025.

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e) Further, as agreed the 1st Party hereto Sahoo has also executed a relinquishment deed before the SRO, Thiruporur on 05.02.2025, in respect of his half share in the residential property situated at Flat No.E, 17th Floor, Block – Topaz, Olympia Opaline Sequel, Phase – II, OMR Road, Rajiv Gandhi Salai, Navalur Village, Chegalpattu Taluk, Kancheepuram – 600130 in favour of the 2nd party hereto. The 2nd party has also received the original copy of the said relinquishment deed dated 05.02.2025 from the SRO, Thiruporur and as such the 2nd party acknowledges the receipt of the same.

7. By signing this Agreement, the Parties hereto state that they have no further claims or demands against each other with respect to CRP.No.3599/2024 pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras and all disputes and differences in this regard have been amicably settled by the Parties hereto through the process of Conciliation/Mediation.

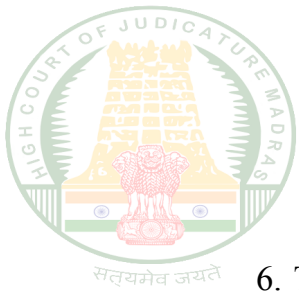
