ORDER

The present writ petition has been filed with a prayer for certiorarified mandamus, to quash the impugned order in Proc.No.10142/B2/2024 dated 08.03.2024.

Though the learned counsel for the petitioner has challenged the impugned suspension order dated 08.03.2024, he restrict his prayer that the petitioner's representation dated 16.06.2025 be considered in the light of G.O.Ms.No.81, Human Resources Management (N) Dept, dated 04.08.2022. 6. With the above observations, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition stands closed.

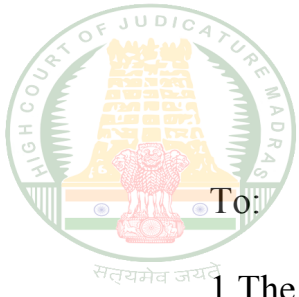
