This order will now dispose of the captioned 'Writ Miscellaneous Petition' [hereinafter 'WMP' for the sake of brevity].

2. Captioned WMP has been filed under Rule 15 of 'Madras High Court Writ Rules, 2021' [hereinafter 'Writ Rules 2021' for the sake of convenience and brevity] with a prayer to file a single writ petition.

3. The support affidavit does not adequately articulate the grounds for a common writ petition. However, in the hearing, learned counsel for writ petitioners submitted that source of writ is the same, the rights sought to be exercised is the same and that the relief is common. Though such averments have to find place in the support affidavit, in the case on hand, we make a departure and as a one off case, we are considering the oral submission made at the Bar.
