2.The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking issuance of Writ of Mandamus directing the first respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 28.08.2024 for closure of the School and resume the petitioner's land situated at survey number 103 at No.2/71, Kumaran Nagar, Jawahar Nagar Post, Chennai.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner have been running School and over the years student strength were vintling and there is no purpose in conducting School.
