PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the 3rd and 4th respondents to consider the petitioner online application no.2025/0103/03/370312 dated 21.03.2025 and consequently issue direction to the 3rd and 4th respondent to issue Patta to the petitioner in survey no. 721/2D2A1 to an extent of 0.64 cents of with jurisdiction Sriperumpadur taluk within the limit of Pillaipakkam A block village Kancheepuram District.

ORDER

By consent of learned counsel on both sides, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. The present writ petition is filed praying for a writ of Mandamus directing 3rd and 4th respondents to consider petitioner's online application no.2025/0103/03/370312 dated 21.03.2025 for issuance of patta.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for petitioner that petitioner submitted an online application on 21.03.2025 for issuance of patta in respect of property measuring an extent of 0.64 cents comprised in Survey No.721/2D2A1 with jurisdiction Sriperumpadur Taluk within the limit of Pillaipakkam A Block Village, Kancheepuram District. It is stated that the same has not been considered till date. Aggrieved, petitioner has filed the present writ petition.

4. At the outset, it is submitted by Mr.A.Selvendran, learned Special Government Pleader for respondents that petitioner application dated 21.03.2025 would be considered and appropriate orders would be passed in accordance with



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law after affording the petitioner and other interested parties a reasonable opportunity of hearing within a time frame to be fixed by this Court. Agreed to by the learned counsel for petitioner.

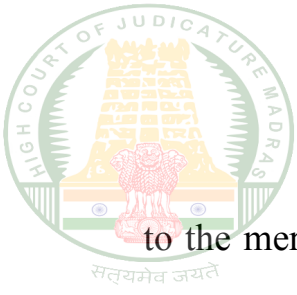
5. In view of the limited relief that is prayed, this court is inclined to dispose of the writ petition with following directions;

i) The appropriate respondent shall consider the application dated 21.03.2025, after issuing notice and affording a reasonable opportunity of hearing to petitioner and all other interested parties including rival claimants, if any.

ii) Though facts have been set out in affidavit, in view of the limited relief that is sought to be granted, I do not propose to examine the same, lest it may influence the authority. The authority shall independently consider the facts and law set out in the representation and pass appropriate order in accordance with law including but not limited to the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Patta Pass Book Act and Rules.

iii) The petitioner's online application dated 21.03.2025 shall be disposed of within a period of 12 weeks from the date of uploading of web copy without waiting for the receipt of certified copy.

iv) It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any views with regard



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to the merits of the case and it is open to the concerned respondent to consider

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the matter on its own merits and in accordance with law. Rights and contentions

of the petitioner and all other interested parties are left open. No costs.
