This case is taken up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. M/s.K.Varadhakamaraj, learned counsel for appellant and Mr.N.Sampath, learned counsel for the second respondent are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Claimants are the appellants, challenging the award of the Tribunal to the tune of Rs.6,81,000/- awarded by the Tribunal in M.C.O.P.No.4417 of 2009 dated 11.02.2016.

2. Today, 13.12.2025, the officials of the Insurance Company and the appellants/claimants along with their respective counsels are present.

3. After negotiation, the parties have now arrived a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- over and above the awarded amount in full quit.

4. It is brought to the notice that the amount awarded by the Tribunal has already been deposited and withdrawn. The remaining amount shall be deposited within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award.



5. On such deposit, the claimants are permitted to withdraw the enhanced amount without filing any formal petition. Award is passed accordingly.

6. The Tribunal is directed to transfer the amount through RTGS/NEFT to the parties concerned on proper identification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of accordingly.
