Side) appearing for the respondents would submit that, dehors the C.S.R. that is pending on the file of the respondent, a complaint was given to the file of the second respondent, namely, the Director, Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Chennai, which is forwarded to the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Chennai and the Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Civil Supplies Corporation, to ascertain the basic facts.
