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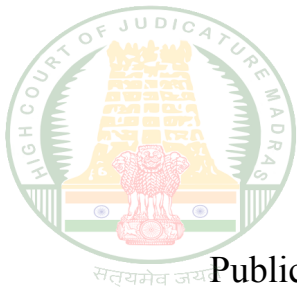
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This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking suspension of sentence imposed by the Special Court for POCSO Act, Puducherry, in Spl.S.C.No.3 of 2017 dated 02.09.2022 , and enlarge the petitioner on bail pending disposal of the above appeal.

2. The petitioner, who is an accused in Spl.S.C.No. 3 of 2017 was convicted and sentenced by the Special Court for POCSO Act, Puducherry, vide judgment dated 02.09.2022, as follows:

5. In the result, the petition for suspension of sentence is dismissed.

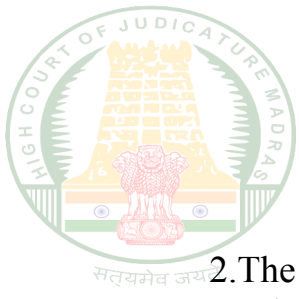
