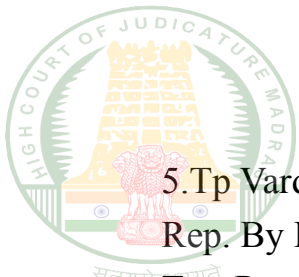

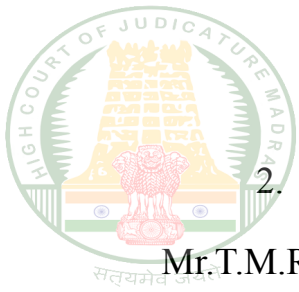
**PRAYER**

Writ petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for the issuance of writ of Certiorari to call for the records of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent in Na.Ka.No.7500/2024/E5 dated 31.12.2024 and quash the same as illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and pass orders.

**ORDER**

This writ petition has been filed challenging the proceedings of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent dated 31.12.2024 and to restrain the respondents from in any way interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the subject property.



2. Heard Mr.Praveen Raj N, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.T.M.Rajangam, learned Government Advocate for Respondents 1 to 3, Mr.V.Meganathan, learned Government Advocate [Crl.Side] for 4<sup>th</sup> respondent and Mr.Satish Parasaran, learned Senior counsel for Mr.Abhinav Parthasarathy & Mr.Suhael Buttan for 5<sup>th</sup> respondent.

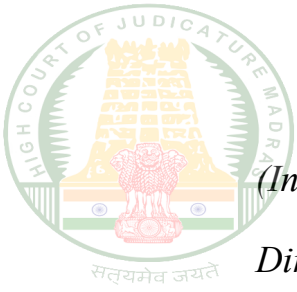
3. It is seen from records that this Court in the earlier round had passed an order in WP Nos. 2233 etc., batch of 2025 dated 17.03.2025. These writ petitions were disposed of in the following terms:-

*H. The Result:*

*9. In view thereof, these Writ Petitions are disposed of on the following terms,*

*(i) The order issued by the 2nd respondent in W.P.No.3202 of 2025, namely, the Central Electricity Authority, Ministry of Power, Government of India, published in the Gazette of India dated 22.10.2024, being as the licence under Section 164 of the Electricity Act, 2003, shall stand quashed;*

*(ii) The fourth respondent in W.P.No.3202 of 2025, namely TATA Power Renewable Energy Limited (TPREL), shall be entitled to continue from the stage of effecting publications as mandated under the procedure in English Newspaper (In one issue of anyone of the news papers viz., The Hindu, The Times of India, Deccan Chronicle in Coimbatore Edition) and in Tamil Newspaper*



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*(In one issue of the anyone of the news papers viz., Dinakaran, Dinamalar, Daily Thanthi in Coimbatore Edition), in the same approved format they had previously used, within two weeks from the date of receipt of the website-uploaded copy of this order. They shall observe the mandatory period of 60 days, consider any observations or representations that may be received from any individual, and finalise the optimal route alignment.*

*(iii) With the certificate mandated in the procedure, they shall reapply to the second respondent, The Central Electricity Authority, Ministry of Power, Government of India, to grant a license. The 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent shall consider the application and issue an order in accordance with the law within four weeks from the date of receipt of such application from TPREL; If the license is granted under Section 264 of the Electricity Act, 2003, then accordingly it has a right to enter into the lands and complete the erection of towers and drawal of the lines in accordance with the route finalised;*

*(iv) If necessity arises, they shall apply the name of TPREL, to the District Collector, Tiruppur, under Section 16 of the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885, and when such application is made, the same shall be disposed of as indicated supra within four weeks from the date of application;*

*(v) The towers already erected by TPREL/TPVSL shall*



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*not be interfered with by anybody and shall stand protected until the above exercise is carried on afresh, and the user or removal thereof will depend on the ultimate result of the above exercise.*

*Due protection shall be ensured by the Tahsildar, Dharapuram Taluk and the Superintendent of Police, Tiruppur.*

4. Thereafter, the matter was listed for being mentioned on the ground that certain mistakes have crept in the order and those mistakes were corrected by an order dated 20.03.2025.

5. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner on the ground that the order passed by this Court has not been complied with and an attempt is being made to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the property.

6. The learned Government Advocate produced the written instructions received from the RDO, Dharapuram. The relevant portions are extracted hereunder :-

பார்வை 3-ல் காணும் TP VARDHAMAN SURYA LIMITED நிறுவனத்தின் கடிதத்தில், மேற்கூறிய மாண்புமிகு சென்னை உயர்நீதிமன்ற தீர்ப்பின் அடிப்படையில் பொது அறிவிப்பு மேற்கொள்ளப்பட்டு, 72 விண்ணப்பங்கள் உயர் இழப்பீட்டுத் தொகை வரப்பெற்றதில், 57 நபர்களுக்கு சுமுகமான முறையில் இழப்பீட்டுத்தொகை வழங்கப்பட்டதாகவும், மீதமுள்ள நபர்கள் அரசு நிர்ணயித்த தொகையை விட அதிக உயர் இழப்பீடு கோருவதால், அரசு வழிகாட்டிலின் அடிப்படையில் உயர் இழப்பீட்டுத்தொகை வழங்க தயாராக உள்ளதாக தெரிவிக்கப்பட்டுள்ளது.



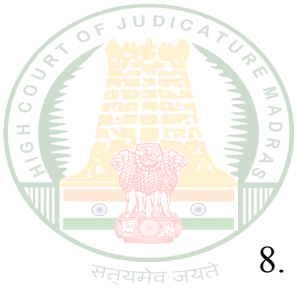
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மேலும், நாளது தேதியில் 18.3km தூரத்திற்கு 68 மின் கோபுரங்கள் அமைக்கப்பட்டு, 12.5km கம்பி வடம் இழுக்கப்பட்டு 95% பணியானது நிறைவடைந்ததாகவும் தெரிவிக்கப்பட்டுள்ளது.

மனுதாரர் கே.சுப்பிரமணி என்பவரால் மாண்பும சென்னை உயர்நீதி மன்றத்தில் [W.P.NO:26473](#) Of 2025-ல் பத்தி 11ல்- 2nd Respondent The Revenue Divisional Officer, Dharapuram 3rd Respondent Tahsildar, Dharapuram பாத்தியப்பட்ட எரசினம்பாளையம் கிராமம் ரீ.ச.146/1 மற்றும் 146/2A-ல் அத்துமீறி மேற்படி பணிமேற்கொண்டதாக தெரிவிக்கப்பட்டுள்ளது.

இந்நேர்வில், மேற்படி தீர்ப்புரைக்கு பின்னிட்டு M/S TP VARDHAMAN SURYA LIMITED S Section 16(1) of the Telegraph Act- 5 ல் பிறப்பிக்கப்படவில்லை என்பதையும், TP VARDHAMAN SURYA LIMITED நிறுவனத்தினர் மாண்பும சென்னை உயர்நீதிமன்ற வழிகாட்டுதலின்படி தனிநபர் பேச்சுவார்த்தை அடிப்படையில் பணிகள் மேற்கொண்டு வருவதாகவும் தெரிய வருகிறது.

7. The first portion of the prayer sought for by the petitioner to quash the proceedings dated 31.12.2024, *per se* is not maintainable since the same has already been interfered by this Court in the earlier order that was passed in the batch of writ petitions in WP Nos.2233 etc., of 2025. Therefore, the petitioner once again seeking to quash the same proceedings is uncalled for. With this cause of action, the petitioner is seeking to restrain the respondents not to interfere with the possession and the said relief has been claimed only with a mere apprehension, without any material to sustain the same. The authorities are in the process of following the procedure as was directed in the earlier order passed by this Court. Hence, no further orders are required to be passed in this writ petition.



8. This writ petition is disposed of in the above terms. No costs.

Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
