COMMON ORDER

These Writ Petitions have been filed seeking a direction to the respondent to refer the matter relating to the acquisition of lands in S.No. 138/1 measuring 0.71.5 hectares, S.No. 439/3 measuring 0.24.5 hectares and S.No. 439/4 measuring 0.22.5 hectares, situated at Moranapalli Village, Hosur Taluk, Krishngiri District, in respect of the award proceedings on the file of the second respondent under Award Nos.4/2007 and 3/2007 passed under Section 8 of the Tamil Nadu Act 10 of 1999.
