Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to pay the petitioner the amount payable towards the encashment of 51 days of earned leaves surrendered by him in the years before his retirement,

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to pay the petitioner the amount payable towards the encashment of 60 days of earned leaves surrendered by him in the years before his retirement, as admitted by the respondent in the RTI information dated 17.03.2025, either based on his monthly wages of the respective months of surrender of those earned leaves, together with 18% interest p.a. from the respective due dates or based on the monthly wages payable on the month of his retirement, together with 18% interest from the date of his retirement, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

Prayer in W.P.No.26565 of 2025:

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to pay the petitioner the amounts, payable towards the encashment of 45 days of earned leaves surrendered by her in the years before her retirement

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to pay the petitioner the amounts, payable towards the encashment of 60 days of earned leaves surrendered by him in the years before his retirement and Employees Retirement Benefit Scheme, as admitted by the respondent in the RTI information dated 19.11.2021 and 21.04.2025, together with 18% interest from the respective due dates, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

Prayer in W.P.No.26582 of 2025:

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to pay the petitioner the amount payable towards the encashment of 45 days of earned leaves surrendered by him in the years before his retirement, as admitted by the respondent in the RTI information dated 17.03.2025, either based on his monthly wages of the respective months of surrender of those earned leaves, together with 18% interest p.a. from the respective due dates or based on the monthly wages payable on the month of his retirement, together with 18% interest from the date of his retirement, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.
