This petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 265 days in filing the appeal.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Despite the receipt of notice, on behalf of the first respondent, none represented.

4. The learned counsel for the second respondent does not have serious objections in allowing the petition.

5. The petitioner would aver that due to the injuries suffered on account of accident, she was unable to attend her job and she is the sole bread winner and taking care of the family. She has been struggling to take care of her needs and meet day-to-day expenses. Hence, the delay of 265 days occurred in filing the appeal.

6. Accepting the averments made by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to allow this Civil Miscellaneous Petition subject to the condition that the interest for the delay period of 265 days shall stand waived.
