ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on
14.06.2025, for the offence punishable under Section 483 of I.P.C. Act, 5 (l),
5 (j) (ii) and 6 of POCSO Act, and Section 9 of Prohibition of Child Marriage
Act, 2006, in Crime No.23 of 2025, registered on the file of the respondent,



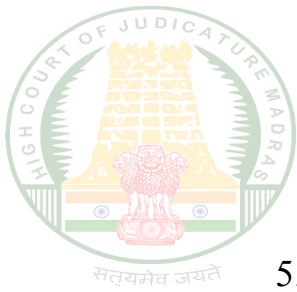

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2.The case of the prosecution is that the victim girl is aged about 16 years old. The petitioner and the victim girl were in love with each other. The victim girl without informing her parents eloped with the petitioner and living together. Thereafter, they also involved in physical relationship, due to which, the victim girl got pregnant. Hence, the parents of the victim girl lodged a complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner and the victim girl were in love with each other. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 14.06.2025 and hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police reiterated the prosecution case and submitted that 164 statement of the victim girl has been recorded and she confirms that the petitioner and the victim girl were in love with each other.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, submissions made by the learned counsels on either side and the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Session Judge, Fast Track Mahila Court, Dharmapuri**, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] **the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of two weeks; thereafter as and when required for interrogation;**

[c] the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;

[d] the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly cause any threat to the de facto complainant and witnesses;

[e] the petitioner to give an undertaking that if required for being identified by witnesses during investigation or for police custody beyond the first fifteen days, he shall comply to the directions as may be given by the Court in this regard;

[f] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
