Mr.N.Naveen Kumar, learned Government Advocate takes notice



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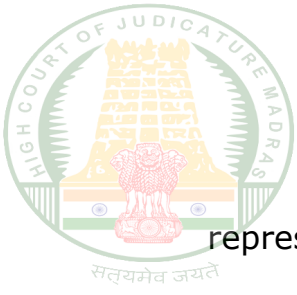
on behalf of the respondent. By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.
