ORDER

This writ petition has been filed challenging the impugned endorsement dated 17.06.2025 of the Commissioner of Land Administration refusing to entertain the revision filed by the petitioner as against the order passed by the District Revenue Officer, Krishnagiri, dated 05.05.2025.

2. Heard Mr.V.R.Kamalanathan, learned counsel for petitioner, Mr.T.M.Rajangam, learned Government Advocate appearing for



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respondents 1 to 4, 7 & 8 and Mr.K.Karthikeyan, learned counsel
appearing for respondents 5 & 6.

3. In the considered view of this Court, the impugned endorsement dated 17.06.2025 does not suffer from any illegality. Insofar as rectification of defects in the UDR is concerned, the District Revenue Officer is the competent authority to consider the same. If ultimately, the District Revenue Officer passes an order, a revision will not lie before the Commissioner of Land Administration. Either the order passed by the District Revenue Officer is to be challenged before the High Court by filing a writ petition if sufficient grounds are made out, else a suit has to be filed before the competent Court to establish the title over the property. Therefore, liberty is granted to the petitioner to work out his remedy accordingly. No further orders can be passed in this writ petition.

This writ petition is disposed of in the above terms. No costs.
