PRAYER Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 483 of BNSS, pleaded to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in connection with Crime No.282 of 2022, pending investigation on the file of the respondent police and thereby render justice.

**ORDER**

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The Petitioner, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 294(b), 323, 392, 397 & 506(ii) of IPC, in Crime No.282 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of prosecution is that on 10.04.2022, at 08.30 p.m., the petitioner along with other accused waylaid the defacto complainant and robbed a sum of Rs.350/- at knife point and subsequently escaped from the scene of occurrence. Hence this case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for respondent would submit that there are 15 previous cases pending against the petitioner. However, he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

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6. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to **deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) to the credit of the Crime No.282 of 2022 and the victim is permitted to withdraw the same without prejudice to the right and contentions**, and on such deposit, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, for a like sum to the satisfaction of the *learned Judicial Magistrate, Ambattur, Thiruvallur District*, and on further conditions that:

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police on every Saturday at 10.30 a.m. for the period of eight weeks.

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;



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(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]*; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
