ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for the issue of writ of Mandamus directing the 2nd respondent to consider the representation made by the petitioner on 07.02.2025 pursuant to the proceedings dated 06.03.2025 of the 1st respondent.

2. Heard Mr.A.Ilayaperumal, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.G.Velu, learned Additional Government Pleader for respondents 1 and 2 and Mr.S.Ravichandran, learned Additional Government Pleader for 3rd respondent.

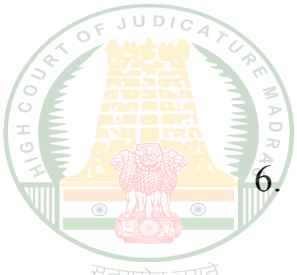
3. The grievance of the petitioner is that he is the absolute owner of the subject property and he has also put up construction. There was some damage to the superstructure and hence, the petitioner has demolished the said construction. The 4th respondent at that point of time approached the petitioner and promised that she can get the benefit from the Government under a scheme



for constructing the house. Believing the 4th respondent, the petitioner gave the particulars and taking advantage of the same, the 4th respondent has received benefits for the building the house in her name under the Pradhan Manthiri Housing scheme by showing the petitioner's property.

4. The petitioner gave a complaint in this regard to the 1st respondent and the 1st respondent has already forwarded the same to the 2nd respondent for enquiry. Since there was no progress, the present writ petition has been filed before this Court.

5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of grievance expressed by the petitioner and considering the materials placed before this Court, there shall be a direction to the 2nd respondent to deal with the representation made by the petitioner after affording opportunity to the 4th respondent and take a decision, on its own merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



6. This writ petition is disposed of with the above directions. No costs.

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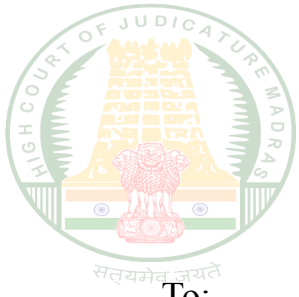
