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ORDER

WEB COPY This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the C.C.No.188 of 2023 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Poonamalle, thereby taken cognizance for the offences under Sections 420, 406, 506(i) of IPC, 1860 and Section 92 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

2. Pending this petition, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3. A Joint Memo of Compromise has been filed before this Court, which has been signed by the petitioner and the defacto complainant and also by their respective counsel. All the parties are present and identified by their respective counsel and the Police. This Court also enquired both the parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4. Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the proceeding pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **2017 9 SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujrath)**, this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C, quashes the proceeding in

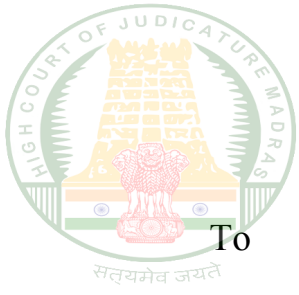
Magistrate-I, Poonamalle.

5. In view of the above, the proceedings in C.C.No. 188 of 2023 pending trial on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Poonamalle, is hereby quashed as against the petitioners. The terms of Joint Memo of Compromise shall form part and parcel of this Order. The petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.10,000/-, (Rupees Ten Thousand only) as costs, to the Chief Justice Relief Fund, Tamil Nadu, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance in the Registry.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
