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are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The claimant is on appeal, challenging the award of the Tribunal for a sum of Rs.93,000/- (Rupees Ninety Three Thousand only), with interest at 7.5% per month, for the injuries suffered by the claimant, in M.C.O.P.No.6962 of 2018 dated 12.08.2024.

2. After negotiations, the parties have now amicably arrived at a settlement for a sum of Rs.80,000/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand only) as full quit over and above award by the Tribunal.

3. The 2nd respondent is directed to deposit the above said accepted amount of Rs.80,000/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand only) in full quit without interest, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award.

4. On such deposit, the claimant/appellant is permitted to withdraw the enhanced award amount, without filing any formal petition. Award is passed accordingly.



5. The Tribunal is directed to transfer the amount through RTGS/NEFT to the parties concerned on proper identification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of accordingly. The connected miscellaneous petition is closed, if any.
