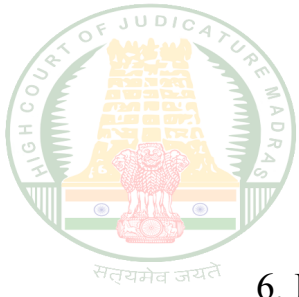
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2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the first to third respondents and perused the materials available on record.

4. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the first to third respondents would fairly submit they would consider the petitioner's representation within a reasonable time.

In view of the above submission, without going to merits of this Writ Petition, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 04.07.2025, and pass orders on its own merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



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6. In the result, this Writ Petition is disposed of with the above directions.
