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ORDER

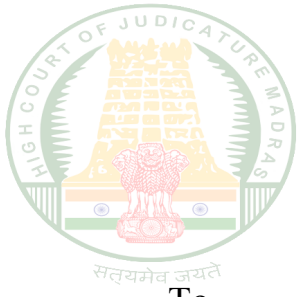
The prayer that is sought for in this writ petition is to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 15.07.2025.
