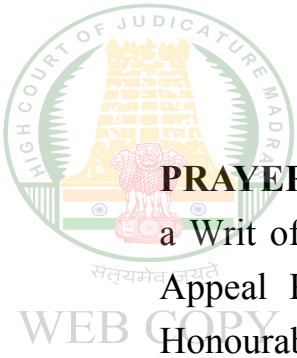

ORDER

By consent of both the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2. The present writ petition has been filed praying for a writ of mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent to dispose of the Appeal filed by the petitioner on 07.05.2025 as against the order of refusal for transfer of patta in respect of the property comprised in TD.No.339/1863(Kasa No.136/2A, 231/1) measuring an extent of 9 Acres 0.70 Cents situated at Nayakkanpalayam



Village, Coimbatore District.

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4. At the outset, it is submitted by the Learned Government Advocate appearing for Respondents 1 to 3 that they would dispose of the Petitioner's appeal dated 07.05.2025 within a time frame to be fixed by this Court. Agreed to by the learned counsel for petitioner.

5. At this Juncture, the Learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the 4th respondent would submit that though it is the claim of the petitioner that he is in absolute possession of the subject property, however, the patta in respect of the said property stands in the name of the 4th respondent.

6. In view thereof, there shall be a direction to the 2nd respondent to dispose of the appeal dated 07.05.2025 filed by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders after affording a reasonable opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as the 4th respondent temple and other interested parties/rival claimants, if any within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of



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It is made clear that, this Court has not expressed any views with regard to the merits of the appeal and it is open to the 2nd respondent to consider the appeal on its own merits and in accordance with law.

7. Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.

Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
