The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking issuance of Writ of Mandamus directing the second respondent to pass orders on the appeal/representation submitted by the petitioner Trust dated 24.07.2023 against the order of fourth respondent dated 07.07.2023 and to direct the second respondent to grant recognition to the School established by petitioner Trust viz., Straight Way Nursery and Primary School, Cumbum, based on the application pending from 13.10.2018, within a time frame.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has already submitted an appeal before the second
