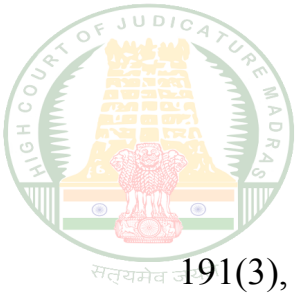

ORDER

The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 21.05.2025, for the offence punishable under Sections 191(2),

191(3), 127(2), 103(1) of BNS in Crime No.223 of 2025, registered on the file of the respondent, seek bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that there was a communal dispute between the petitioner's group and the defacto complainant's son group. The petitioners along with other accused waylaid the deceased and assaulted him with deadly weapons, thereby the deceased sustained injury and died on spot. Hence, the case.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that already co-accused were granted bail by this Court and he further submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent police, while opposing for grant of bail to the petitioner, reiterated the prosecution case.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

6. In view of the fact that the co-accused have been granted bail by this Court and considering the period of incarceration already undergone by the petitioner and the progress of investigation, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on his executing a separate bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate – II, Arakonam, Ranipet District** and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall stay at Trichy and report before the Cantonment Police Station, Trichy everyday at 10.30 a.m. for a period of three weeks,

thereafter as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;

[d] the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly cause any threat to the de facto complainant and witnesses;

[e] the petitioner to give an undertaking that if required for being identified by witnesses during investigation or for police custody beyond the first fifteen days, he shall comply to the directions as may be given by the Court in this regard;

[f] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
