PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue Writ of Mandamus directing respondents 3 and 4 to survey and fix boundaries to petitioner's property situated in survey No.150/17, Elumur village to an extent of 0.5.5 hectares pursuant to petitioner's online application dated 05.04.2025.

ORDER

By consent of learned counsel on both sides, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. The present writ petition is filed praying for a writ of mandamus to direct respondents 3 and 4 to survey and fix boundaries to petitioner's property comprised in Survey No.150/17, measuring an extent of 0.5.5 hectares situated at Elumur village on the basis of petitioner's online application dated 05.04.2025.

3. At the outset, it is submitted by Mr.P.Sathish, learned Additional Government Pleader for respondents that the application dated 05.04.2025 submitted by the petitioner would be considered and appropriate orders would be passed within a time frame to be fixed by this Court, which was agreed to by the learned counsel for petitioner.



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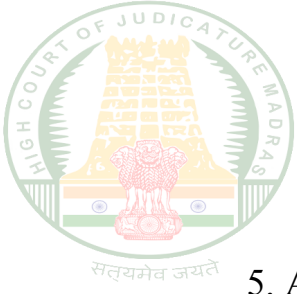
4. In view of the limited relief that is prayed, this court is inclined to dispose of the writ petition with following directions:

i) The respondents 3 and 4 shall consider the application dated 05.04.2025 in accordance with law, after issuing notice to the petitioner, adjacent land owners and all other interested parties including rival claimants, if any.

ii) Though facts have been set out extensively in the affidavit, this court does not propose to deal with it while leaving it open to the respondents 3 and 4 to call for any document/conduct enquiry to satisfy itself of the petitioner's entitlement for requesting survey of subject property.

iii) The entire process shall be completed/appropriate orders passed within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of uploading of web copy without waiting for the receipt of certified copy.

iv) It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any views with regard to the merits of the case and it is open to the concerned respondent to consider the matter on its own merits and in accordance with law. Rights and contentions of the petitioner and all other interested parties are left open.



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5. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of. There will be no order as to costs.
