The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody
on 08.07.2025, for the offence punishable under Sections 8(c), 20(b)(ii)(B)
of NDPS Act, 1985 in Crime No.388 of 2025, registered on the file of the
respondent, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other accused person, was found in possession of 3.500 kgs of ganja. Hence, the case.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police submits that the investigation has not yet been completed and there is no previous case, similar in nature, against this petitioner.

4. Considering the period of incarceration already undergone by the petitioner and no bad antecedents against this petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Special Court for E.C Cases at Coimbatore**, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and

[Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

[c] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;

[d] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
