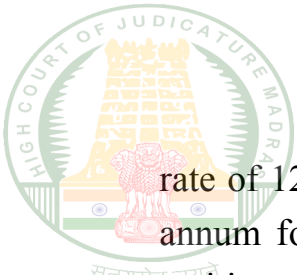

PRAYER: directing the respondents to pay the petitioner a sum of Rs.18,500/- towards the amount payable under the Post Retirement Benefit Fund Scheme, a sum of Rs.4,500/- towards the IRT Contributions, to pay the petitioner a sum of Rs.35,457/- towards the amount payable surrendered earn leave wages for 60 days, to pay the petitioner a sum of Rs.12,000/- the amount payable under the balance amount in the variable dearness allowance together with interest at the



rate of 12% per annum and to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 12% per annum for the belated payment of Rs.8,25,046/- towards Gratuity, to pay the petitioner interest for the belated payment of Rs.4,55,416/- towards PF to pay the petitioner interest for the belated payment of Rs.1,25,307/- towards surrendered earned leave/medical leave within a specified time frame.

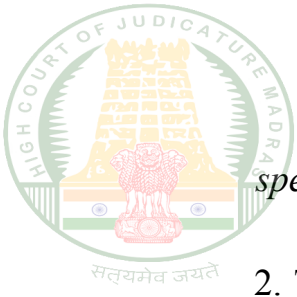

ORDER

The writ petition is filed for the below relief:

directing the respondents to pay the petitioner a sum of Rs.18,500/- towards the amount payable under the Post Retirement Benefit Fund Scheme a sum of Rs.4,500/- towards the IRT Contributions, to pay the petitioner a sum of Rs. 35,457/- towards the amount payable surrendered earn leave wages for 60 days, to pay the petitioner a sum of Rs.12,000/- the amount payable under the balance amount in the variable dearness allowance together with interest at the rate of 12 percent per annum and to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 12 percent per annum for the belated payment of Rs.8,25,046/- towards Gratuity, to pay the petitioner interest for the belated payment of Rs.4,55,416/- towards PF to pay the petitioner interest for the belated payment of Rs. 1,25,307 towards surrendered earned leave/medical leave within a



specified time frame.

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2. The brief facts which are culminated in the filing of this writ petition are set out below:

2.1. It is the case of the petitioner that he joined the service of the 1st Respondent Corporation as a Conductor on 03.08.1985. He attained the age of superannuation on 31.05.2018. Though the petitioner retired on 31.05.2018, the retirement benefits had been settled only after a delay of 7 months. However, the Respondent had not paid the interest for the belated payment of PF and Earned leave salary. Similarly, the payments under Family Benefit fund, Post retirement Benefit Fund Scheme, 1992 and IRT contributions also not settled by the Respondent. The petitioner had made a representation to the 1st Respondent on 27.06.2025 and the same was not considered to date. Therefore, the petitioner is before this Court.

3. Heard the learned Counsels on either side and perused the records.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions of both side counsels, a mandamus is therefore issued to the Respondent to pay the eligible amount as payable to the petitioner along with



interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the delay period in settling the said amount. The payment shall be made within a period of two months from the

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date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is made clear that if the amount is not paid within the time frame fixed by this Court, it will fetch an interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date on which the amount became due and payable till the date of actual disbursement.

5. With the above directions, the Writ Petition stands Allowed. No costs.
