Today, *Mr.R.Subramani*, learned Counsel appeared on behalf of the petitioner.



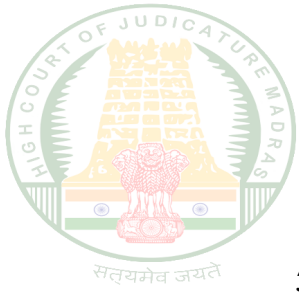

Since, a query was raised by this Court on the earlier occasion with reference to his eligibility, placing reliance on the Bar Council of India Rules, dated 12.01.2015, he would submit that he is eligible inspite of his conviction in another case and he is not connected to the present case.

3. In view of the submission made, this Court permitted the learned Counsel to appear and argue the matter. After that, the learned Counsel appeared on behalf of the petitioner sought permission to withdraw the Writ Petition with a liberty to pursue his remedy as against the order passed by the Trial Court, dated 25.04.2023 in Crl.M.P.No.4649 of 2022 in C.C.No.13 of 2020.

4. *Ms.T.Sugirtha*, learned Counsel for the petitioner on record also appeared through online and consented for the same.



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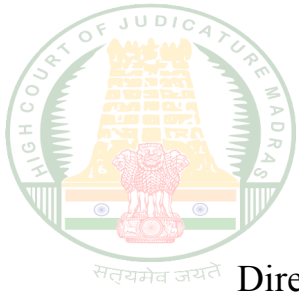
