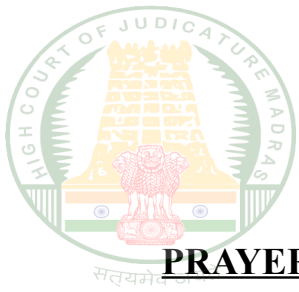

accused on 23.05.2025. As the bailable warrant has not been executed by the

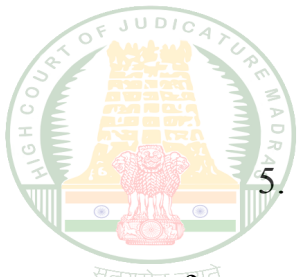
second respondent, the case is pending without any progress. Hence, the
