2. The learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruthani shall do well to forthwith consider the Final Report and pass orders thereon in accordance with law.

It is also brought to the notice across the bar that in view of making of filing of Final Report through e-filing compulsory and since there was filing of huge number of cases, there is piling up of these Final Reports for scrutiny and there are also other difficulties such as deputing of staff, working of the portal etc. However, these arrears have to be cleared within a reasonable time.
