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Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent.

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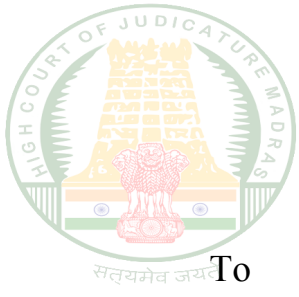
