ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 21.07.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 281, 125(b), 110 BNS and 194(2), 115 of MV Act in Crime No.399 of 2025 on the file of the respondent, seeks bail.

2. The petitioner herein was arrested in connection with the motor accident wherein the pillion rider of the two wheeler had sustained grievous injury and he is still in hospital.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the petitioner is in prison for one month and the investigation is almost completed.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five**

Thousand only) with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate, Ambattur, Thiruvallur**, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

[c] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;

[d] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
