Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondent.

Being satisfied with the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed along with the petition, the delay of **847** days in filing the civil miscellaneous appeal is condoned, on condition, the petitioner pays a sum of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred) to the credit of 'Chief Justice Relief Fund', within a period of two weeks, failing compliance, the delay petition shall stand automatically be dismissed.

The petitioner is not entitled to claim interest for the delay period.

In case, the above said condition is complied with, within the stipulated time, Registry is directed to number the appeal, if it is otherwise in order, and list the same for admission.

Registry is directed to print the name of Ms.G.V.Shoba counsel for the respondent, at the time of admission.
