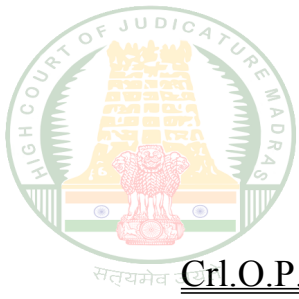

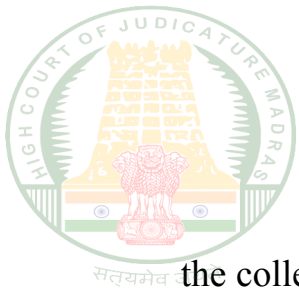

COMMON ORDER

The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial
custody on 08.07.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 115(2),
126(1), 296(b), 87 of BNS Act and Section 4 of TNPHW Act in Crime
No.502 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

2. The complaint indicates that the victim girl was abducted from



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the college campus and taken to a private lodge for the commission of sexual offence.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.It is seen that the statement of the girl would clearly indicates the role of the petitioner herein in the crime. Since the investigation is yet to be completed and the antecedents of the petitioner are not impressive, the Criminal Original Petitions stand dismissed.
