2. Recording the same, the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition stands closed.

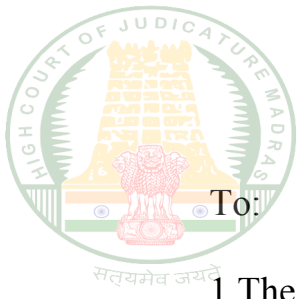
